### Qualifications

- If a graduate student, you must have completed a minimum of 9 hours in graduate technical communication courses at UNT.
- You must be enrolled in 9 credit hours as a graduate student or 12 credit hours as an undergraduate student **during both semesters** of the award period.
- You must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0.

### Undergraduate Application Materials

- **If you have completed under 60 credit hours:** Submit a 750 word essay about what skills you intend to develop as a technical communicator, why you want to develop those skills, and how those skills will enable you to pursue your career goal.
- **If you have 60 credit hours or more:** Submit one portfolio piece (no group projects) and short memo (1-2 paragraphs) providing context for the portfolio piece. The memo is an important part of the submission. Please make sure to explain the choices you made when creating the piece and use the assignment parameters to justify those choices.
